- **Each family must bring at least one bag of candy for trick-or-treaters**

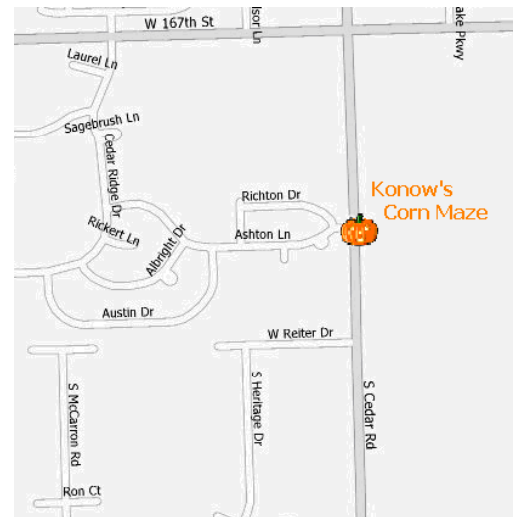
Scarecrow Contest:

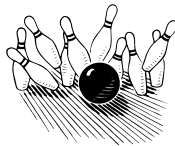
